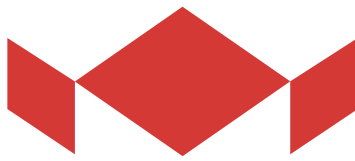

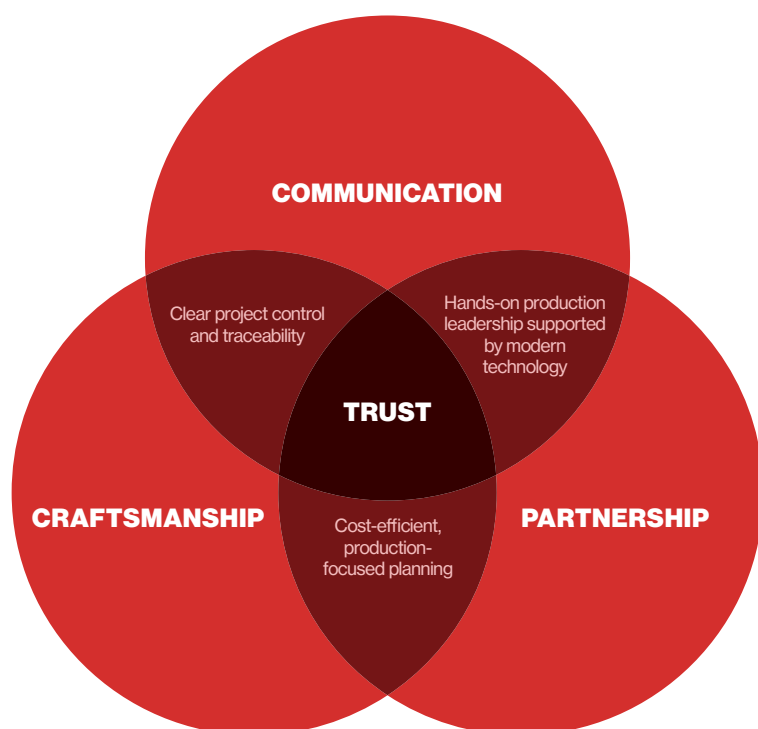

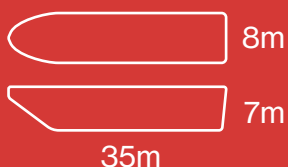

We manufacture reliable aluminium hulls based on customer designs, from one-off builds to series production.

Flexible contract models allow materials to be supplied by either the customer or MarineCraft.

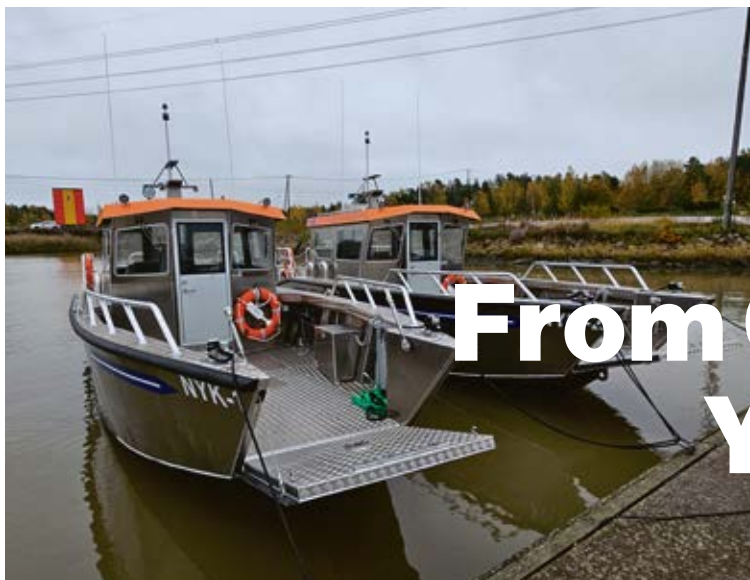

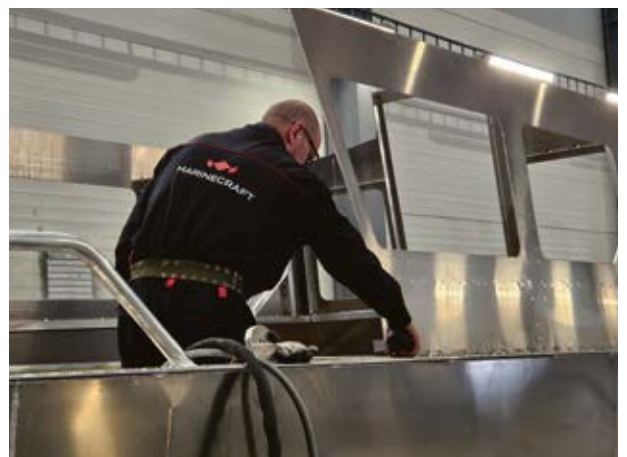

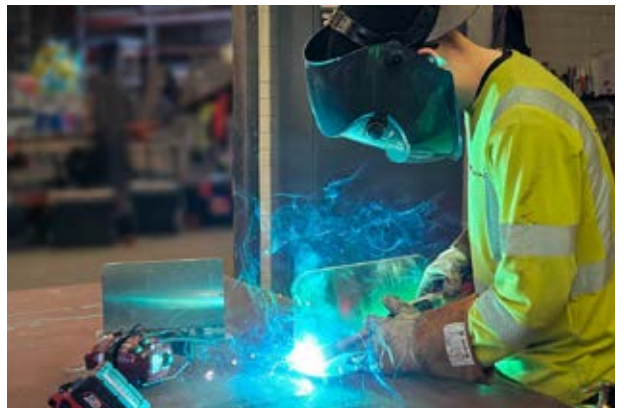
